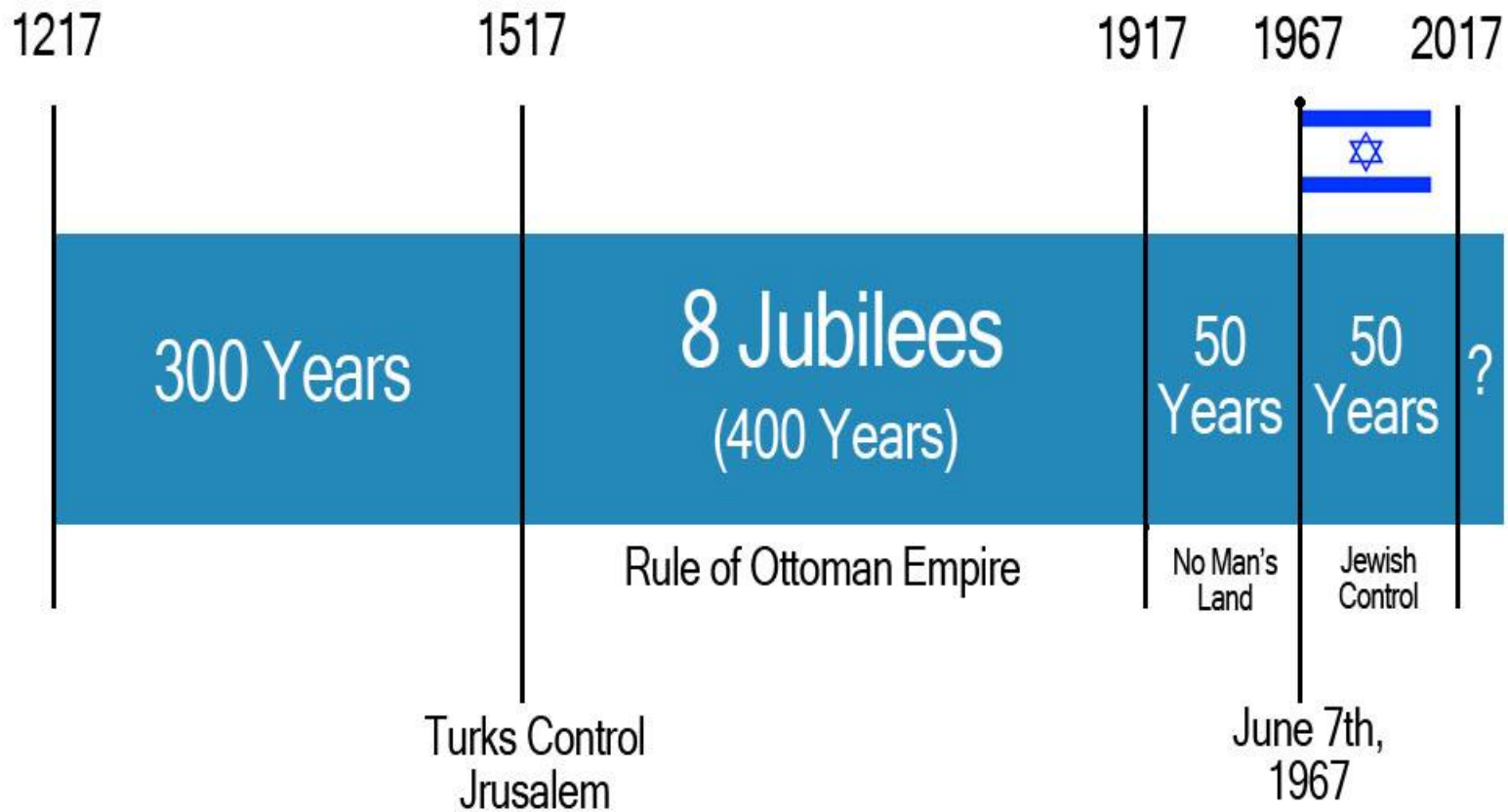

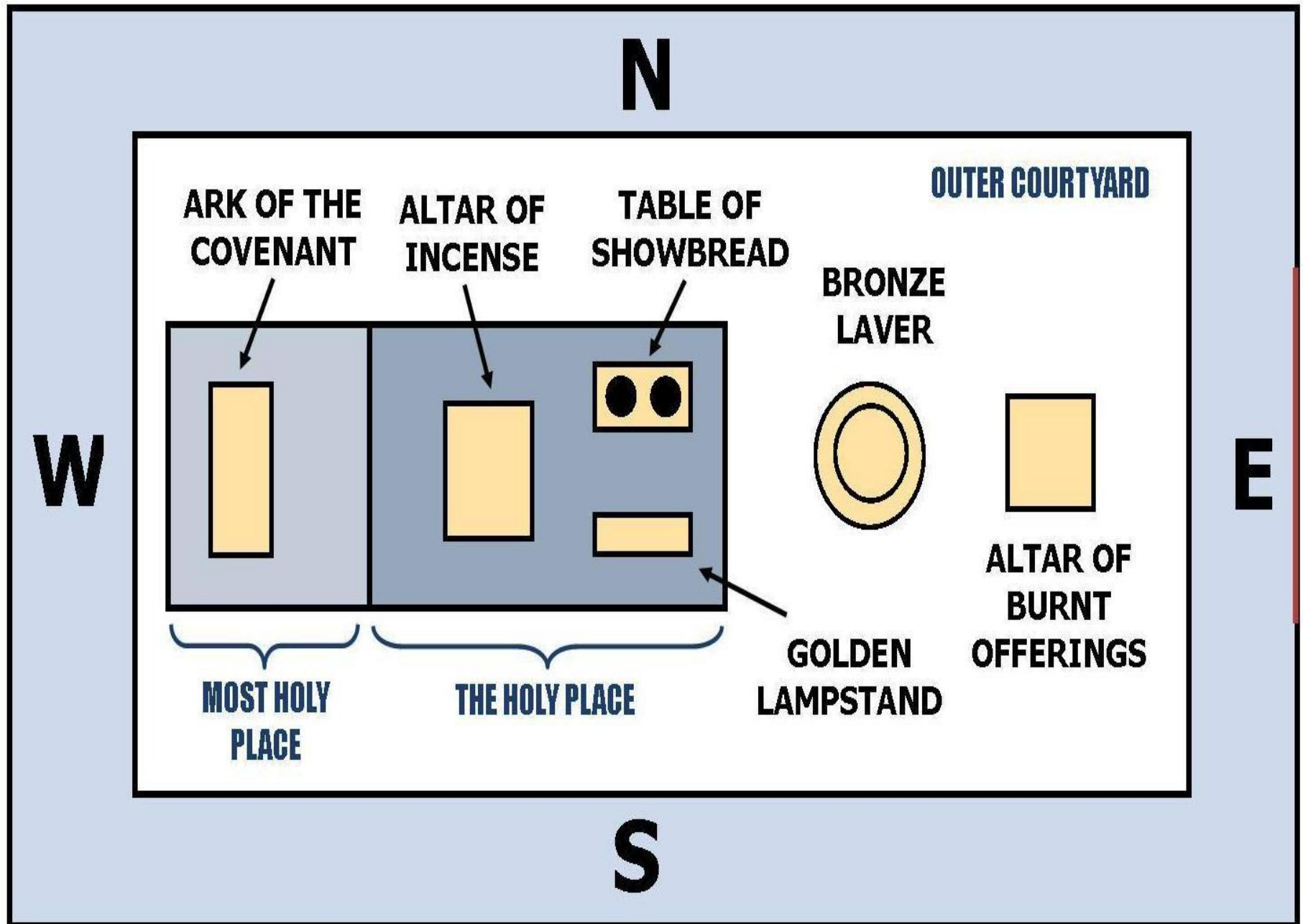

A screen, divider, or separator that HIDES

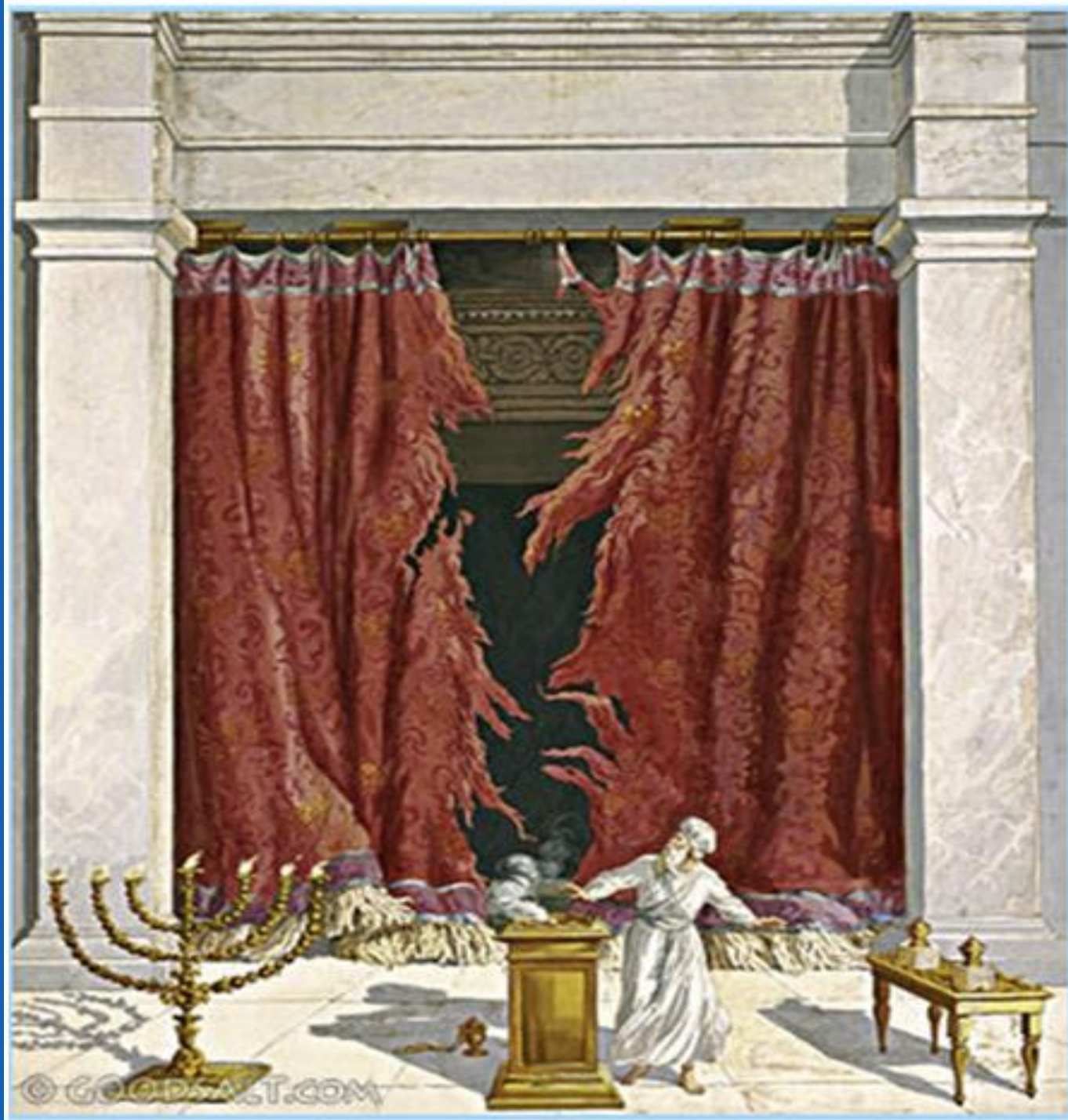


II. THE TORN VEIL

Matthew 27:50-51 (NKJV)

⁵⁰ And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. ⁵¹ Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split...

¹⁷ The will goes into effect only after the person's death. While the person who made it is still alive, the will cannot be put into effect. ¹⁸ That is why even the first covenant was put into effect with the blood of an animal. ...

²⁰ Then he said, “This blood confirms the covenant God has made with you.” ²¹ And in the same way, he sprinkled blood on the Tabernacle and on everything used for worship. ²² In fact, according to the law of Moses, nearly everything was purified with blood.

23 That is why the Tabernacle and everything in it, which were copies of things in heaven, had to be purified by the blood of animals.

But the real things in heaven had to be purified with far better sacrifices than the blood of animals. ²⁴ For Christ did not enter into a holy place made with human hands, which was only a copy of the true one in heaven.

He entered into heaven itself to appear now before God on our behalf. ²⁵ And he did not enter heaven to offer himself again and again, like the high priest here on earth who enters the Most Holy Place year after year with the blood of an animal.

HEBREWS 9:17-19,20-28 NLT

26 If that had been necessary, Christ would have had to die again and again, ever since the world began.

HEBREWS 9:17-19,20-28 NLT

But now, once for all time, he has appeared at the end of the age to remove sin by his own death as a sacrifice. ²⁷ And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment, ²⁸ so also Christ died once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for him.

Hebrews 4:14-16 (NKJV)

14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. **15** For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. **16** *Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace,* that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, **20** by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, **21** and having a High Priest over the house of God, **22** let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith

Zechariah 14:8-9 (NKJV)

⁸ And in that day...living waters shall flow from Jerusalem...⁹ And the LORD shall be King over all the earth...

Zechariah 14:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶ And it shall come to pass *that* everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Zechariah 14:16-17 (NKJV)

17 And it shall be *that* whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain...

Ezekiel 47:1 (NKJV)

¹ Then he brought me back to the door of the temple; and there was water, flowing from under the threshold of the temple toward the east...

Ezekiel 47:8-9 (NKJV)

8 Then he said to me: "This water flows toward the eastern region, goes down into the valley, and enters the sea. *When it reaches the sea, its waters are healed.* **9** And it shall be *that* every living thing that moves,

Ezekiel 47:8-9 (NKJV)

wherever the rivers go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; for they will be healed, and everything will live wherever the river goes...

Ezekiel 47:12 (NKJV)

¹² Along the bank of the river, on this side and that, will grow all *kinds of* trees used for food; their leaves will not wither, and their fruit will not fail. They will bear fruit every month, because *their water flows from the sanctuary*. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for medicine."

Revelation 7:15-17 (NKJV)

¹⁵ Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them. ¹⁶ They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat;

Revelation 7:15-17 (NKJV)

17 for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."
