This is the Jewish year 5777.

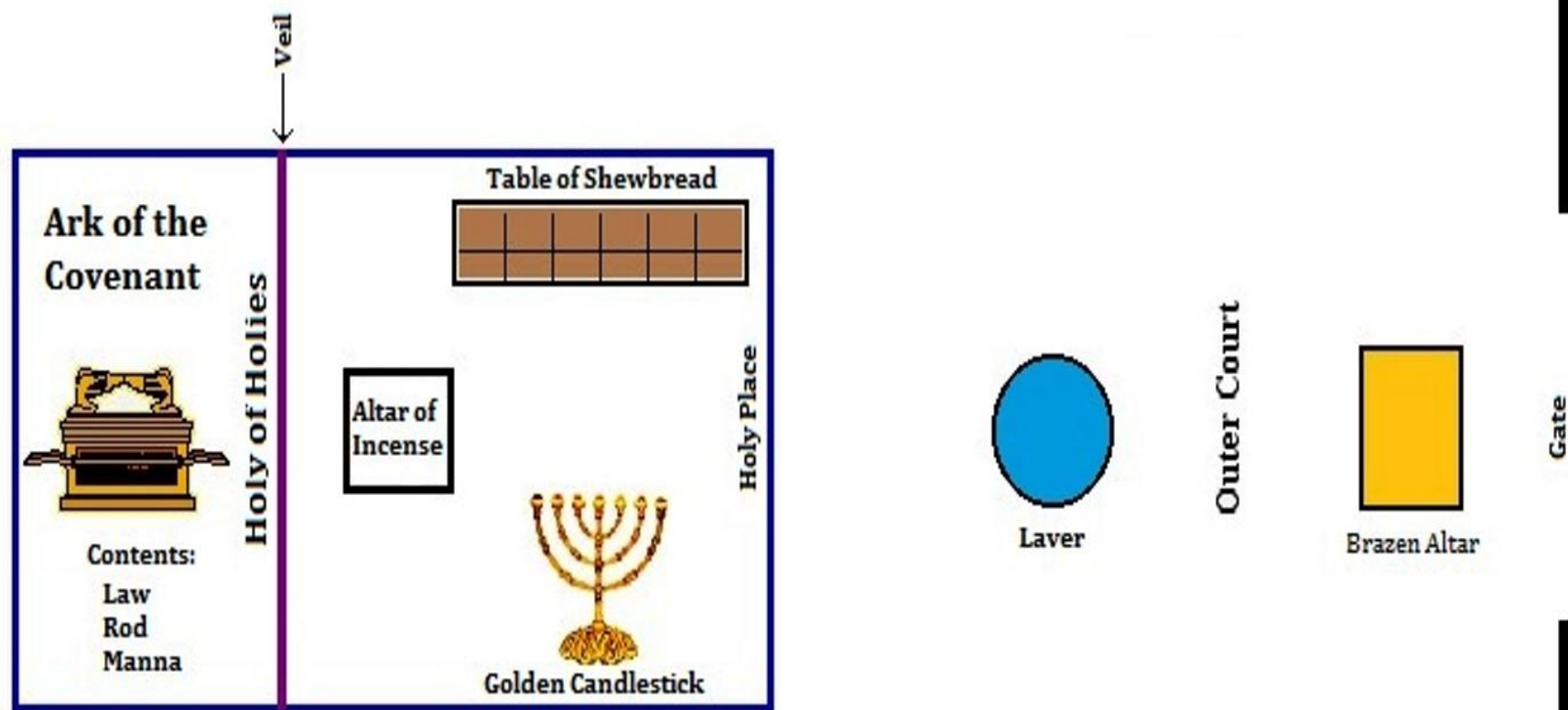
**Yom Kippur is this Tuesday-
